CRASH TEST DUMMIES DON'T SLEEP . . .

UK Child Car Seat Law changes on 18 September 06. All children under 12 who are less than 135cm tall (approx. 4'5") must use an appropriate child restraint from that date.

Unfortunately for the over 4's "appropriate" is being widely interpreted as a basic booster cushion in spite of the fact that child safety experts know there's already a big safety gap between the booster cushion, and a high back booster seat with side impact protection.

If you're about to buy restraints to comply with the new law be sure to make the distinction between what's legal and what's safer.
